Bethesda Mission

East Shore Baptist Church regularly partners with the Bethesda Mission to love our community and reach those less fortunate. Bethesda Mission is a ministry in Harrisburg that reaches out to men, women and children of all races, nationalities and creeds, provides the poor and homeless with shelter, food, clothing, shares the good news of Jesus Christ and disciples them in the Christian life.

An over 100 year old ministry, Bethesda seeks to rescue (by offering food, safety, and shelter), redeem (through the power and love of Jesus Christ), and restore (by equipping people with the knowledge and tools for life). Last year, Bethesda Mission served over 129,000 meals over the course of the year and sheltered around 125 people every night.

Currently we are attempting to collect cans of green beans for Bethesda to distribute this holiday season. If you are able to contribute, both our church and Bethesda Mission would greatly appreciate it.
