### Hershey Volunteers

A unique way our church raises money for our missions is through volunteering time at the Hershey Entertainment Complex's Food and Beverage Department and Rides Department. These volunteer shifts may be

located at Hersheypark, Hersheypark Stadium, Hersheypark Arena, or the GIANT Center.

The church receives \$18 for 3-hour shifts, \$24 for 4-hour shifts, and \$30 for 5-hour shifts. Each volunteer also receives one Hersheypark voucher pass for each shift completed. You can earn money for the church and a ticket for you!
