Missions at East Shore Baptist Church

Today multiple members of East Shore are on a mission trip in the Dominican Republic. These folks are ministering in local churches, working on construction projects, and sharing the gospel with citizens of the Dominican Republic. Please be in prayer for the team.

But the Dominican Republic is not the only place East Shore engages in God's mission to make disciples of all nations (Matthew 28:18-20).

Two weeks ago, 5 members of the church were in the Czech Republic. This team spent their time helping our missionaries reach out to a community with no evangelical churches. They handed out flyers and water bottles and built relationships through English conversations. The team also prayed that God would build His church in the largely unchurched city of Brno.

In Pennsylvania, members of the church are involved in a variety of outreach ministries. We are looking forward to our Vacation Bible School (VBS) in August.
