OFFICIAL QUALIFYING CRITERIA – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - As per Grand National Rules

The Gosnells Riding and Pony Club Inc are a current financial members of the Show Horse Council of Australasia therefore being an Affiliated Club of SHCA

1. To enter this event entries are required to be current financial members of either the SHC of WA or a SHCA affiliated club. The owner of the horse competing, excepting when a horse is leased, then the lessee(s) must be current financial member of the SHC of WA or a SHCA affiliate club and this must be at close of entries and at time of the event.
2. The rider and an official handler (18years and over) for the Leading Rein Classes and the responsible officer for the entry must be current financial members as per ruling 1.
3. Where a person to whom rule 1 does not apply, will need to provide proof of membership with entry to any other SHC of Australasia affiliated club
4. A horse (including rider mounts) competing in the Gosnells Masters must be registered with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc National Saddle Horse Register as the closing date of entries and can only entry show horse or hunters
5. **ALL HORSE REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE CORRECT AND IN ORDER AT TIME OF ENTRY**
6. Stallions are not permitted to enter this event or be on the grounds.
7. This show shall be run in accordance with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc Competition Rules for the Grand National Qualifier. Rules are available to view on the SHCA website
8. The Gosnells Riding and Pony Club Committee and ground dury, shall make any relevant decisions in regard to this event, or arising from any incident at or pertaining to this event, without any claim for damages or recourse of any kind. The Gosnells R&PC committee will make determination in response to any questions not covered in the Conditions of Entry. The decision of the Gosnells Riding and Pony Club Inc shall be final.
9. Entry and Competition in this event is voluntary. The exhibitor and competitors enter and compete entirely at their own risk. By entry it is the Absolute Liability of all participants to agree to be bound by the decisions of the Gosnells R&PC and or the Ground dury and compete in accordance with the Rules applicable to the event.
10. Entry to this event shall constitute an agreement and affirmation by the exhibitor(s), owner(s), responsible officer (which includes lesee(s), manager, rider and handler) to compete subject to and in accordance with the Competition Rules and Rules and Conditions applicable to this event.
11. All information supplied by the exhibitor(s) and/or owner(s) (including Lessee(s)) and/or responsible officer shall be true and correct and represent that the horse and or rider are eligible to compete. If this information is found to be false, the exhibit shall be ineligible to compete. The exhibitor(s) and/or owner(s) and/or responsible officer of the entry may be disciplined by the SHCA.
12. The Gosnells R&PC Committee and/or ground dury, reserve the right to alter the number of Finalists, Programme, Judges, Schedule or Timetable, Date and Venue.
13. The judges decision is FINAL subject to all other conditions.
14. Protests to be submitted no later than 30 minutes from the conclusion of the offending class, in writing and with a \$100 fee. If the protest is dismissed the fee will be forfeited.
15. All competitors MUST have a current height card at time of competition and will be eliminated from all classes, if found not to hold a current SHC height certificate
16. **Leading Rein Ponies – all sections** may only be ridden in a snaffle bit, will be judged on the pony and its suitability as a leading rein mount and pony must not exceed 12.0hh. Rider must be 3 years and under 8 years and must not wear spurs or carry a whip. Handler to be 18 years and over and may carry a cane and a member of SHC
17. **Shetland Pony** – must not exceed 10.2hh AND must be registered with the APSB Society (copy of registration to be available on day/ number included on entry form) Owner/Lessee MUST be current financial members of the APSB and proof to be supplied
18. **First Ridden – all sections** Ponies not to exceed 12.2hh and to be ridden in a snaffle bridle, with a cavesson nose band and will be judged for the suitability of the pony for the purpose intended. Age of rider to be 5 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show. Ponies are to walk or trot only in and out of the ring and during all ring circle work, however a short canter is allowed in the individual workout performance back to the judge. A narrow strap may be attached at the front of the saddle for assistance to the rider. Riders may carry a cane (whip) not to exceed 40cm and spurs ARE NOT permitted. Shetland Ponies are eligible to compete in the First Ridden
19. **STANDARD OF CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR** (taken from National rules 75,76,77,78)
20. Objectional conduct and unseemly behaviour by any person towards a judge, show official, competitor, exhibitor, spectator or Committee member may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc Competition rules.
21. Any competitor/exhibitor/rider who, in the opinion of Gosnells Riding and Pony club Inc and SHCA has caused annoyance by loud or unseemly comment upon the decision of a judge, or upon any act or omission on the part of a judge, or any

official on duty in or about the ring at any time of competition, such person may be expelled from the class and the grounds.

22. A competitor must compete on their own merits. No outside assistance is to be displayed during competition. A person is not permitted to provide instruction in any form to a competitor who has entered the marshalling area or arena to compete in a class. Any behaviour that contravenes this rule may be subject to disciplinary action and penalty of Disqualification may apply to a breach of this Rule.
23. Alcohol is prohibited – the consumption of alcohol may result in disciplinary action and / or disqualification. Riders are not to be under the influence of alcohol during the competition.
24. **Junior Riders** Under 9 years mount not to exceed 14hh
25. **Junior Riders** 9 years to under 12 years not to exceed 15hh
26. All riders in rider classes under 17 years are to wear jodhpur boots
27. All Child's classes are with Finals being held for each section offered – Note WINNERS ONLY of each class qualify for Grand National Championships. Winners DO NOT qualify for the Open Champions. Junior riders for the Childs classes MUST be in short boots (age is under 17 years)
28. **All Childs** Classes - Rider is to be under 17years
29. Swabbing **WILL** take place
30. **No ALCOHOL** to be consumed on the grounds
31. **No DOGS** on the grounds
32. The Committee of the Gosnells Riding and Pony Club reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they may deem necessary
33. Competitors are requested not to approach the judges during the events. If you have any queries please come to the clubrooms
34. Protests to be submitted no later than 30 minutes from the conclusion of the offending class, in writing and with a \$100 fee. If the protest is dismissed the fee will be forfeited
35. Ground Jury will have any final decision and cannot be protested!
36. Rings will NOT be held up waiting for riders to swap rings, please make sure you have a reserve rider who is eligible to ride as per the conditions of entry – this WILL BE ENFORCED! Ring sitters are permitted
37. A rider may only have a maximum of two mounts per class (ring sitters required)
38. Please ensure that you close the gate on both entry and especially on leaving the grounds
39. If the owner of the horse is in charge of the horse during the competition then the owner of the horse must sign the entry as the responsible officer
40. If a person other than the owner of the horse is in charge of the horse during the competition, then that person must sign the entry as the responsible officer
41. In all cases, the responsible officer will be in charge of the horse at the venue. The safety of the horse and others in relation to that horse will be deemed at this person's responsibility.
42. A responsible officer must be a current financial member of the SHC of WA or a SHCA affiliated club at the close of entries and on the day of competition.
43. IMPORTANT: A parent of legal guardian of a minor (under 18 years of age) who is competing at this event must be a financial member of the SHC WA or SHCA affiliated club at the time of competition and at close of entries
44. A responsible officer must be in attendance when the horse is in competition and must be available should they be called upon.
45. PLEASE NOTE: in the event of disciplinary action the person considered 'responsible' should be the person signing as the RESPONSIBLE OFFICER
46. **Approved Safety helmets MUST be worn by all competitors**
47. PLEASE leave space for other users to access the yards - if you park in front of them, please leave access to the gates
48. Measuring - NO STALLIONS OR COLTS permitted on the grounds for this event - this includes for the measuring bay
49. All visitors just attending for the measuring - MUST attend the office and pay the ground fee, sign a disclaimer and obtain a coloured wrist band
50. No PARKING in front of the disabled bays at the club rooms - someone might actually be disabled and need to use them - extra car parking can be on the grass past the sheds and measuring bay - along the fence line
51. NO PARKING on the hill behind the club rooms - with vehicles or floats - this is the septic tanks and is at a risk to drive over them

Entry to this event is by application only, with offers to Champions and Reserves in Show Horse, Show Hunter, Rider, Leading Reins and Winner Only in ALL Child's Classes. Qualifiers are also selected from Royal Shows, Horse of the Years and the SHC Classic. We are proud to announce that the Masters has been accepted once again as a qualifying event for the 2017 Grand Nationals.
