## TOUCHSTONE FARM

### **RULES FOR UNOFFICIAL ENTRIES and GROUND RULES**

1. Pre -entries preferred - but may enter on the day - fee will apply
2. **Competitors are required to provide breast plate number holders**
3. Height certificates are required for this competition
4. Rider event –Copy of Birth Certificate to be supplied IF REQUESTED for Junior Riders on the day
5. Rider's age is on the day
6. Competitors are requested not to approach the judges during any events. If you have any queries please come to the clubrooms
7. The Committee of the Gosnells Riding and Pony Club Inc reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they may deem necessary
8. If you have been placed in a Rider Class in the Official Ring you cannot compete in Rider Classes in the Unofficial Rings.
9. Unofficial Rings to be held on both days – horses and ponies that normally compete in the Official Rings are not eligible for these classes and those that have qualified for the 2015 or 2016 Perth Royal show are not eligible – also if you normally compete in the Official Rings you CANNOT come back to these rings. Written applications for exemptions to be considered - by close of pre-entries!
10. Pony's can compete in all sections, but riders can only compete in one section
11. Leading Rein Pony is 12.2hh and under, rider 8 years and under
12. First Ridden to pony 14hh and under, rider 10 years and under (note suitability for size of pony to rider will be taken into consideration at time of judging)
13. Protests to be submitted no later than 30 minutes from the conclusion of the offending class, in writing and with a \$100 fee. If the protest is dismissed the fee will be forfeited
14. Ground Jury will have any final decision and cannot be protested!
15. Please ensure that you close the gate on both entry and especially on leaving the grounds
16. **NO ALCOHOL** TO BE CONSUMED ON THE GROUNDS
17. **NO DOGS** on the grounds Please!!
