










EVICTION IN KC (1999-2016)

POPULATION PER SQ MILE




EVICTIONS PER SQ MILE




EVICTION IN KC (2016)

EVICTIONS PER SQ MILE









EVICTION BY POVERTY

EVICTIONS PER SQ MILE (1999-2016)




POVERTY (%)




EVICTION BY BLACK POP.

BLACK POP. PER SQ MILE




PREDICTING EVICTION


USING ONLY THESE VARIABLES, WE CAN PREDICT WITH 90+ PERCENT ACCURACY WHETHER A CENSUS TRACT WILL HAVE >100 EVICTIONS PER 1000 RESIDENTS. RACE IS BY FAR THE MOST IMPORTANT VARIABLE, EVEN WHEN WE HOLD INCOME CONSTANT.
