Community Development Committee Minutes
June 17, 2013

The regular meeting of the Community Development Committee was called to order by the chairman in compliance with open meeting laws at 6:00 pm on Monday, June 17, at City Hall. Present were Bruce Charles (chairman), Judy Wiese, Mike Glime, Ron Welch, Tina Marie Kazmierczak, John Pabich and Russ Ritchie. Jodi Zimmerman and Shawn Olson were absent.

Moved by Russ, second by John: to approve the agenda as published. Motion carried.

Moved by Mike, second by Judy: to approve the May 20 meeting minutes. Motion carried.

The financial report was reviewed. There were no bills to approve.

Signage for the business park was discussed. A drawing of one potential design was provided by Olson Fabrication and will be include in the letter/survey package being sent to existing businesses in the business park. At the next regular meeting, the committee will assess business interest in the project and willingness to provide support on the basis of the survey responses.

Six business ideas generated at the April 15 meeting were identified as being consistent with the 2013 CDC Smart Goals. These same concepts could be folded into the 2014 CDC workplan, which will be developed along with the 2014 budget at the next regular meeting.

There was a consensus to invite Jennifer Brown (KCEDC), Joy Krieger (AACC) and Mike Glime (Main Street) to make short presentations at the next meeting. The committee is interested in learning the mission of each organization and the activities being pursued to achieve the mission.

The committee was updated on the status of the TEA Grant for Mueller Street and the CDBG-RLF applications. Property maintenance citations issued in the last 30 days were discussed. The committee will discuss sale parameters for lots in the new business park at the next regular meeting. This information will be provided to the city administrator for future inquiries.

Moved by Mike, second by Ron: to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 pm.
