ENFORCEMENT OF ORDINANCES

22.01 ENFORCEMENT OF ORDINANCES. Pursuant to the authority of sec. 66.119 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the City of Algoma, hereby elects to use the citation method of enforcement of ordinances other than those for which a statutory counterpart exists.

22.02 THE CITATION.

The citation shall contain the following:

The name and address of the alleged violator.

Factual allegations describing the alleged violation.

The time and place of the offense.

The section of the ordinance violated.

A designation of the offense in such manner as can readily be understood by a person making a reasonable effort to do so.

The time at which the alleged violator may appear in court.

A statement which in essence informs the alleged violator:

That a cash deposit based on the schedule established by this chapter may be made which shall be delivered or mailed to the Clerk of County Court of Kewaunee County or the Algoma Police Chief or his designated officer prior to the time of the scheduled court appearance.

That if a cash deposit is made, no appearance in court is necessary unless subsequently summoned.

That if a cash deposit is made and the alleged violator does not appear in court, the nonappearance will be deemed a plea of no contest, summons will be issued for the alleged violator to appear in court to answer the complaint.

That if no cash deposit is made and the alleged violator does not appear in court at the time specified, an action may be commenced to collect the forfeiture up to the maximum permitted by law.

A direction that if the alleged violator elects to make a cash deposit, the statement which accompanies the citation shall be signed to indicate that the statement required under (g) above has been read. Such statement shall be sent or brought with the cash deposit.

The form of the citation is attached hereto and is incorporated into this chapter by reference.

22.03 SCHEDULE OF DEPOSITS.

The following uniform bond, deposit, penalty, and assessment schedules as applicable to misdemeanors, traffic violations and juvenile drinking violations.

"The Wisconsin Uniform Misdemeanor Bail Schedule."

"The State of Wisconsin Revised Uniform State Traffic Report Schedule."

"The State of Wisconsin Juvenile Drinking Violation Deposit Schedule."

All deposit figures herein to be increased by seven and no/100 (\$7.00) dollars court costs, or actual court costs in effect at time of offense.

Deposit shall be paid in cash, money order or certified check to the clerk of county court of Kewaunee County or the Algoma Police Chief or his designated officer who shall provide a receipt therefor.

22.04 ISSUANCE OF CITATIONS. Any law enforcement officer may issue citations for enforcement of any ordinances authorized under this chapter.

22.05 PROCEDURE. The provisions of sec. 66.119 (3) relating to violator's options and procedure or default are hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

22.06 NON-EXCLUSIVITY. Adoption of this chapter in no way precludes the adoption of any other ordinance or providing for the enforcement of any other law or ordinance relating to the same or any other matter. The issuance of a citation under this ordinance in no way precludes the proceeding under any other law or ordinance relating to the same or any other matter.
