Fire Department,

Fire Department completed annual hose testing. Each length of hose is test to assure it meets NFPA standards.

Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services performed an onsite audit on April 28, 2015, although there are a limited number of recommendations from the auditor, the fire department is in substantial compliance.

Police by Chief Deputy Cornelius:

Wrote a Ballistic Vest grant for two new vests, were approved and it will cover 50% of the vest cost of \$900.

Nine letters were sent to property owners not in compliance with property upkeep. They will be enforcing the ordinance this week if property is not cleaned up

Officers patrolled Truck routes, observed approximately 30 semi trucks and found all were in compliance with city Truck Routes. Does not appear to be an issue

Finance and Personnel Committee approved two part time officers, Eric Jose and Anthony Shallow.

There are two candidates that will be on an eligibility list for future vacancies for part time staff.

New process was started for dealing with Liquor License approval, so far it is working well.
