

Minutes of the Protection of Persons and Property Committee

The May meeting of the City of Algoma PPP committee was called to order by Chairman Bruce Charles at 4:00 p.m.

Roll Call: Charles, Mueller, Cmeyla, Ortleib, Dart.

Also present: Fire Chief Tom Ackerman, Chief Deputy Dave Cornelius, Samantha DeGrave, Dan Heinrick.

This meeting was held in compliance with Wisconsin Open Meeting Laws.

Dart made a motion and seconded by Cmeyla to approved the agenda, carried.

Cmeyla made a motion and seconded by Orlieb to approve the May 26 minutes, carried.

Public comments: Samantha DeGreve spoke to the committee on issues going on in all areas of the city, such as homes being egged, frozen paint balls, bikes stolen. She said police reports have been filed but doesn't feel like any action is being taken. She said her mother has installed deer cameras, motion lites and has a dog and yet the vandalism continues. Deputy Cornelius responded in the incidents mentioned and said it is difficult to stop the vandalism unless the police are notified immediately. He suggested that Samantha start a Neighborhood Watch. Deputy Cornelius agreed to meet and future discuss these issues with Samantha.

Dan Heinrick spoke on his desire to start a business called "Dan's Green Rides" in which he would give people rides throughout the city on his 4 seat electric golf cart. Deputy Cornelius suggested he contact his insurance company on any liability issues and the DOT for any possible regulations

Rescue Report:

34 calls this month making 171 YTD calls. The air conditioning was repaired in both ambulances. Koss did some preliminary checking into power cots, the cost for just a lift would be approximately \$18,000 and for one that moves up and down, in and out would be approximately \$45,000.

Deputy Cornelius handed out the Crime Stat sheet for the State of Wisconsin for the Algoma Police Department.
