**Police by Chief Deputy Cornelius:**

Cookout organized by former Alderman Ken Taylor for Algoma Police Dress uniforms was held Saturday, August 8, 2015 and was very successful.

Possibly holding another fundraiser in September, 2015, to finish out the uniforms would be a pork chop dinner special.

2016 Budget, goals and objectives have been completed and forwarded to the City Administrator for review and approval.

Last 2 hires have successfully completed FTO program for the Algoma Police Department. Both are currently working on the schedule and taking calls.

Shanty Days have only 2 offsite calls. Rest of the event was very peaceful. No calls to Shanty Days Grounds for any problems this year.

New computer system is operational and the bugs are being worked out.

Act 71 has been brought up again, this is a Law approved in the State of Wisconsin in 2013 to allow hunting in the city limits.

There will be a meeting with Mayor, City Administrator, Building Inspector, Street Super, Utilities Director and Chief Deputy Cornelius to establish protocol for buildings that are not up to code.

Officer Jose is starting to do property checks in the city on every Tuesday from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to monitor compliance of all city ordinances for lawn upkeep.
