Police by Chief Deputy Cornelius:

Received a radio bill from Bay Electronics for repair of the part-time officers radio. The cost was picked up through the WISCOM grant. This will be the last bill that will be covered.

Former Alderman Taylor issued a check to the Police Dept for approximately \$1900.00 from the steak sandwich fund raiser, after expenses were paid, the profit was \$1100.00. There is

another fundraiser on October 1, 2015 and will be a pork chop meal for \$6.00 a plate. Again the fund raiser will be to raise money for dress uniforms for the Police Department.

Humane officer issues being reviewed and a final program to be in place for next PPP meeting.

October 5, 2015, Deputy Cornelius will be at a Symposium Best Practice's in Community Safety sponsored by Congressman Reid Ribble.

Currently have one officer on FMLA for Family Leave for Child Care on and off. Sgt. Roesch will be out on FMLA for a period of 8 to 12 weeks. Working with part time officers to cover the time off.

Police are having issues with a person in the community that continuously calls 911 for rescue calls and when they show up the person refuses transport. Police Dept. is working with the DA's office to see if some charges can be put on this person for several state violations.

Deputy Jose is doing property checks, the program is doing very good and make an impact on the community.
