**A PROCLAMATION HONORING RITA SCHIESSER
FOR HER YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE ALGOMA PUBLIC LIBRARY**

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser earned her Bachelor of Science in Liberal Arts from the University of River Falls in May of 1972, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser accepted a position with the City of Algoma, as an Adult Services Librarian on August 31, 1987, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser obtained and retained continuing education and certifications necessary to advance her career, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser accepted the position as Library Director on January 1, 2005, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser started the Adult Book Group during her time with the City, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser successfully wrote: (1) a State of Wisconsin Literacy and Lifelong Learning grant to provide daycare facilities with a rotating selection of children's print materials, (2) an Algoma Utility grant for a new computer for the library employment station, and to form a partnership with Door County Job Center to provide job services to the unemployed in Kewaunee County; and (3) a utility grant to fund a scanner to preserve unique local historical documents, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser supported Kewaunee County Literacy Partners and Algoma Night Out 2006, 2007, 2008, 2012 and 2013, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser was dedicated to making the Algoma Public Library a vital part of the Community, and developing and promoting new library programs, and

WHEREAS, Rita Schiesser retired from service to the City on Saturday, December 26, 2015


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wayne R. Schmidt, Mayor of the City of Algoma, do hereby commend Rita Schiesser for her years of service.
