Police by Chief Deputy Cornelius:

Tanner Tanck was hired as a part time officer and has started his FTO Program for approximately 4 to 5 weeks.

Officer Eric Jose has been offered a Full Time Position with Sturgeon Bay Police Department and will be starting with them on Feb. 20, 2016. He will be staying on as Humane Officer.

Officer Quinn Button will be starting with Door County Sheriff's Dept in February or March but plans on staying on with the Algoma Police Department.

Paging issues for EMS and Fire was not a system problem but another agency wanted to test each department separately.

Parking issues with back of City Hall have been tabled as there is a referendum which may address the parking issues.

Sgt Roesch is still out on FMLA and will be back April, 2016. Officer Allen is back from his FMLA leave.

FMLA protocols are being studied by the City Administrator and Deputy Cornelius . A protocol will be in place to address long and short term FMLA issues along with Workman's Comp and leaves of absence.

The Server and Computer system is up and running.

Deputy Cornelius will be interviewing applicants for part time help.

The Algoma Police Dept along with the Kewaunee County Sheriff's Department, Kewaunee Police Dept., and the Village of Luxemburg and Casco will in place in the next 30 to 60 days introduce a Sex Offender Placement Ordinance for the whole county to follow
