

PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

April 12th, 2016

The meeting of the Parks & Recreation Committee was called to order at 7:00 PM on April 12th, 2016 at the Youth Club.

Members Present: Kevin Schmidt, Mitch Groessl, Paula Wiese, Sara Olejniczak, and Russ Nockerts

Also Present: Sara Robertson and Lynn Trukey

Moved by Olejniczak, second by Groessl to approve February minutes.

Moved by Groessl, second by Wiese to approve bills for February and March.

Public Comment: Lynn Trukey presented a proposal to make improvements in the garden beds at Christmas Tree Point. She proposed planting low maintenance plants, installing a row boat for photo opportunities and also placing the metal silhouette of a ship in the bed. Motion made by Groessl, second by Olejniczak to approve the plans and move them on to the Marina Committee.

Old Business:

- Rentals: March: Youth Club Rentals- 7, Knudson Hall- 3
April: Youth Club Rentals- 5, Knudson Hall- 1, School Incentive Days- 2, Events- 1
- The replacement door for Knudson Hall came in and will be installed this week. The purchase price was \$960 and will be paid out of the CB- Building Maintenance account. When we get reimbursement for the damaged door, we will deposit that back into the Community Building account.

Supervisor Report:

- Programming Update: Breakfast with the Easter Bunny was a success with 90 bags of candy handed out to area children. Art on the Wild Side with Door County Ministry Health is having a 5 week program on Wednesdays after school. Beyond the Bell is also going well.
- Parks Update: Park signs that were painted over the winter have been put back up. Noah Vandermuss has been working a few hours to help us get caught up with cleaning parks and preparing baseball and softball fields. The flower selection for this summer has been made. Street Department and Park crew will take down the snow fence and starting grooming the beach. Local Scout, Eli Derrene has finished his eagle project of making recycling bins for Crescent Beach and will deliver them in the next few weeks. Thank you to Eli for his work and Friends of Crescent Beach for their donation towards the project.

New Business:

- Using money from the Knudson Fund, Robertson recommended that we replace six more LED lights in the Youth Club area. Motion made by Wiese, second by Olejniczak to approve purchase. Motion carried.
- Committee discussed options for the seasonal part time employees and concluded that the 70 hours to be worked will be split between Noah Vandermuss and Derek Johnson. Robertson also

recommended the hiring of Maddie Prokash to help with T-ball and Saturday Morning Basketball. She will also be trained to help at the counter at the Club.

- Robertson updated the committee on future summer programs, including Miss Mary's Performing Arts and Butterfly Theater starting July 13th and running on Wednesday till August 24th. This will be for children ages 4-10. We are also planning the Summer Park Program, a Super Swim session, T-Ball for kids ages 5-6 and a cooking class.
- The committee discussed the Algoma Library Outdoor Movie at Legion Park and decided to assist the event in other ways, in lieu of a monetary donation.
