



City of Algoma  
Common Council Organizational Meeting  
Tuesday, April 19, 2016

The April 19, 2016 organizational meeting of the Algoma Common Council was called to order by Mayor Schmidt at 4:31 P.M. in the Council Chambers.

Present at roll call: Alders Barlow, Charles, Dart, Mueller, Kevin Schmidt, and Wiese. Absence excused at roll call: Dachelet and Grossl.

It was noted that the meeting was in compliance with the open meeting law.

A motion was made by Dart, and seconded by Wiese, to approve the agenda for the meeting. Motion passed.

Public Hearing

Mayor Schmidt opened the public hearing on the City of Algoma Wastewater Treatment Plant Facilities Plan, which will provide guidance for wastewater management over the next 20 years and beyond by calling upon the Strand Associates Engineering to present an overview of the plan. Following this presentation the Mayor called upon those present and wishing to comment on the budget to step forward. However, no one appeared to comment on this matter, and upon a motion by Barlow, and seconded by Schmidt, the hearing was declared closed by the Mayor.

A motion was made by Dart, and seconded by Wiese, to approve a motion to: (1) approve the selection and hiring of Steven W. Hansen Jr. as a part-time Police Officer for the City of Algoma, WI. and (2) at a pay rate of \$15.00 per hour. Motion passed.

The Common Council postponed until a later date making the selection and hiring of limited term seasonal marina workers.

Dart moved, and Mueller seconded, a motion to recommend that Common Council approve Resolution No. 768 – 2015 relating to contracting with Oil Equipment Company, Inc. for a marina fuel tank replacement project.

A motion was made by Schmidt, seconded by Wiese, to accept the Board of Canvassers report for the April 5, 2016 spring municipal election. Motion passed.

The Oath of Office was administered by Administrator – Clerk – Treasurer Wiswell and recited by Mayor Schmidt.

The Oath of Office was next administered by Administrator – Clerk – Treasurer Wiswell and recited by Alderpersons-elect Kevin Schmidt, Janice Mueller, James Barlow, and Janice Dart, as new members of the Common Council.

Mayor Schmidt accepted nominations for the office of Council President. Barlow moved to nominate Schmidt to serve as President of the Council. With no other nominations offered, Barlow moved, seconded by Schmidt, to close the nominations and to elect Schmidt to serve as President. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Schmidt accepted nominations for one council position on the Planning Commission. Dart moved, seconded by Barlow to nominate Alderperson Groessl to serve as the council representative on the Planning Commission. With no other nominations offered, Barlow moved, seconded by Schmidt, to close the nominations and to select Alderperson Groessl to serve as council representative on the Planning Commission. The Mayor called the question and the motion passed.

Mayor Schmidt accepted nominations for the Office of City Attorney. Dart moved, seconded by Groessl, to nominate Attorney James A. Downey and Jacob M Blazkovec of the Algoma law firm of Blazkovec, Blazkovec & Downey to serve as City Attorneys. Barlow moved, seconded by Dart, to close the nominations and to select the law firm of Blazkovec, Blazkovec & Downey to serve as City Attorney. The Mayor called the question and the motion passed.

Schmidt moved, seconded by Dart, to grant authority to the Administrator – Clerk – Treasurer to the appoint at his discretion either the Green Bay Press Gazette or the Door County Advocate as the newspaper of record for the city of Algoma. Motion passed.

Barlow moved, seconded by Mueller, to appoint the Algoma, WI Branches of the Bank of Luxemburg, Baylake Bank, and First Merit Bank; Casco, WI Branch of BMO Harris Bank; and the Sheboygan, WI Branch of Commerce State Bank, each as depositories for the City Of Algoma, WI. Motion passed

Groessl moved, seconded by Schmidt, to approve the Mayor's Common Council appointments, and the Mayor's citizen appointments, as attached, to all city boards, committees, and commissions. Motion passed.

A motion was made to adjourn at 5:38 P.M. by Alder Schmidt and seconded by Alder Groessl. The motion carried, and the council stood adjourned.
