A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A STORM WATER PUMP
TO REPLACE THE NON-OPERATIONAL MANUAL BACKUP PUMP
AT THE 6TH STREET PUMPING STATION

WHEREAS: The City of Algoma maintains a storm water pumping station at the north end of 6th Street which serves to evacuate excess surface level water during major rain events from a large section of the City south of the Ahnapee River; and


WHEREAS: The existing backup (manual) pump is not operational and due to its age is not repairable; and

WHEREAS: Proposals have been requested from several vendors for replacement of this pump;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Common Council of the City of Algoma, Wisconsin hereby authorizes the Administrator – Clerk – Treasurer of the City of Algoma to purchase a replacement storm water pump, at a cost not to exceed \$26,000.00.
