Fire Department

Rescue Report:

- 46 calls this month
- 275 call YTD
- Members participated in all the Shanty Days activities, i.e. Parade, 1st Aid station for Run/Walk, Porky-Pancake breakfast.
- A committee has been formed to seek out specs and bids for a new ambulance to be received in 2017.

Police by Chief Deputy Cornelius:

- Squad 231 was in for repairs, done by Seiler Tire.
- Shanty Days went very well with very few complaints.
- Police department along with other department heads meet on August 16, 2016 with officials from the City of Oconto. The meeting was very productive and will be looking at some ideas learned from the meeting.
- Soar on the Shore was August 20-12, 2016. The rain didn't help but the police department has no calls for issues on the event.

- Planning and scheduling is in the works for Wine Fest 2016 and final schedule will be available September 6, 2016.
- Budget 2017 has been issued to City Administrator Wiswell but that is not the final breakdown until Police contact is finalized.
- 196 calls for service in the month of August.
- Officer Jacob Jandrin has accepted a full time position with the Kewaunee County Sheriff's department and started August 21, 2016. We will continue to look for additional officers for the part time rank for the city. Officer Jandrin will stay on as a part time officer for the city.
- Officer Mason Wagner is currently going the FTO program and will be taking shifts in the next 2 weeks.
- The Algoma Police Administrative Contract with the Kewaunee County Sheriff's department is signed and there is no increase for the next 28 months. The contract will remain the same with the same service at \$58,500.00 per year.
- The Algoma Police Department received validation for all the officers of the department for the year 2016 through the State of Wisconsin Training and Standards Bureau. **Request for Training:**
