

ORDINANCE 777

AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT PROHIBITING
THE SPREADING, SPRAYING OR STORAGE OF LIQUID MANURE
IN THE CITY OF ALGOMA, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS: The Common Council of the City of Algoma has the authority to promote the public health, safety and welfare pursuant to the general grant of authority to the city according to Wisconsin Statutes, Section 62.11 (5), and

WHEREAS: The Common Council finds that the land application of liquid manure using center pivot sprinkler technology has the potential to increase disease, pollution, and the creation of offensive odors, and

WHEREAS: the City of Algoma desires to reduce the potential for disease, pollution, and the creation of offensive odors.

NOW, THEREFORE the Common Council of the City of Algoma does ordain that:


- I. Chapter 11 of the Algoma Code of Ordinances and entitled public nuisances is amended as follows:


At Section 11.03, (1) PUBLIC NUISANCES AFFECTING HEALTH, add section:

(e) Spreading, spraying, or storage of liquid manure, where liquid manure is defined as manure with a solids content of less than 12% as referenced in Wisconsin law.

- II. This ordinance amendment shall apply to all properties located in the City of Algoma, and
- III. This ordinance amendment shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

Adopted by the Common Council of the City of Algoma, Wisconsin at a regular meeting thereof on the 7 day of July, 2014, by a vote of 8 for and 0 opposed.
