ORDINANCE NO. 782 – 2015

**CITY OF ALGOMA
COUNTY OF KEWAUNEE
STATE OF WISCONSIN**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT RELATING TO THE GRANTING OF
PROVISIONAL AND TEMPORARY OPERATOR'S LICENSES FOR
INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES
IN THE CITY OF ALGOMA, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS: The Common Council of the City of Algoma has the authority to promote the public health, safety and welfare pursuant to the general grant of authority to the city according to Wisconsin Statutes, Section 62.11 (5), and

WHEREAS: The Common Council finds that it is necessary to provide the procedure for obtaining a provisional operator's license pursuant to Wis. Stats. Sec. 125.17(5) and for the issuance of temporary operator's licenses.

NOW, THEREFORE the Common Council of the City of Algoma does ordain that:

I. Section 9.01(3) (g) of the Algoma Code of Ordinances is created as follows:

"9.01(3) (g) Provisional Operator's License.

1. The City Clerk shall issue provisional operator's licenses in accordance with Sec. 125.17(5), Wis. Stats. The provisional operator's license shall expire sixty (60) days after its issuance or when an operator's license is issued or denied by the Common Council whichever is sooner. A provisional license shall not be issued to any person who has been denied an operator's license by the Common Council or who has had his operator's license revoked or suspended within the preceding twelve (12) months. The City Clerk shall provide an appropriate application form to be completed in full by the applicant. The City Clerk may revoke the provisional license if he or she discovers that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application.

2. The annual fee for a provisional operator's license shall be as prescribed in the City of Algoma fee schedule."

II. Section 9.01(3) (h) of the Algoma Code of Ordinances is created as follows:

'9.01(3) (h) Temporary Operator's License. A temporary operator's license may be issued provided that:

48 1. A temporary operator's license may be issued only to persons
49 employed by or donating their services to not for profit corporations or civic
50 organizations.

51
52 2. No person may hold more than one temporary operator's license per
53 calendar year.

54
55 3. A temporary operator's license shall be valid for any period from one
56 (1) day to fourteen (14) days, and the period for which is valid shall be stated on
57 the license.

58
59 4. The fee for a temporary operator's license shall be prescribed in the
60 City of Algoma fee schedule.'

62 III. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided
63 by law.
