

Ordinance 763
Allowing dogs on Crescent Beach from October 1st to May 1st

WHEREAS, the Common Council of City of Algoma feels that to reduce the amount of geese and other birds that occupy and deposit animal waste on Crescent Beach in Algoma dogs will be allowed to be on the beach from October 1st to April 1st to act as a deterrent to the birds.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALGOMA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 11.02(7)(g) of the Municipal Code of the City of Algoma is amended to read as follows:

(g) All animals running at large. No person shall permit any animal to run at large in the City at any time. Owners or custodians of any animals shall confine it to within the limits of their premises or property except when such animal is under control by a leash of not more than six (6) feet in length. For purposes of this selection "running at large" embraces all places within the city except the owners or custodian's premises or an area designated as a dog exercise area by the City of Algoma. No animals shall be allowed in any public park at any time in the City even if they are under leash control except that dogs are permitted in the public portions of Crescent Beach and Crescent Beach Boardwalk from October 1st to May 1st or any time in DeMeuse Park subject to the rules found in Section 9.06(17)(1) of the Municipal Code.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that Common Council of the City of Algoma adopts the changes in this ordinance and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute any documents necessary to carry out the establishment of this ordinance.
