

Ordinance #766

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 346, BULKHEAD AND PIERHEAD LINES

The Common Council of the City of Algoma does hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the Common council of the City Algoma wishes to repeal Ordinance 346 which was created to establish certain pierhead and bulkhead lines along both sides of that section of the Ahnapee River lying east of the Fourth Street Bridge, and continuing easterly to the mouth of Lake Michigan, as contained in section 1.145 of the Algoma Municipal Code of Ordinances.

WHEREAS, THE City of Algoma does not have the resources to effectively and adequately permit and enforce waterway structures.

WHEREAS, by repealing Ordinance 346, the City desires that all future jurisdiction and enforcement of waterway structures be administered by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT ORDAINED, that the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Algoma do hereby repeal Ordinance 346, and request that the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources assume jurisdictional responsibility for all future waterway structures and improvement permits in accordance with the applicable sections of the Wisconsin Administrative Code and State Statutes.


