Counting Rules

Counts on this page are based on the month of the incident or arrest, rather than the month the incident was submitted. To view a report by the month the incident was submitted, navigate to "Submit Data" and select the "Summary" report.

Offense counts were calculated based on the number of offenses for each victim (per incident) for Crimes Against Persons and the number of unique offense types (per incident) for Crimes Against Property and Crimes Against Society.

Victim counts were calculated based on the number of victims connected to each unique offense type in an incident. For Crimes Against Persons, the number of victims will be equal to the number of offenses. Victims will be counted more than once if they are connected to multiple offenses.

Arrest counts were calculated based on the number of arrestees listed on a Group A or Group B incident. Arrests are categorized based on the specific Group A or Group B arrest code, rather than the incident offense code.
