March 14th, 2017

The meeting of the Parks & Recreation Committee was called to order at 7:00 PM on March 14th, 2017 at City Hall.

Public Comment: Mike Lucas met with the Parks Committee to discuss Legion Baseball League and the possibility of adding more home games to Perry Field. The Trailblazer team is a group of youth from Sturgeon Bay, Southern Door and Algoma. More discussion will follow with field maintenance worker, Mike Salzsieder, to see if adding 8-10 games will be something he can manage. Field fees will be discussed at next month's meeting.

- Committee reviewed that the City will charge a player fee for participants in the local leagues. Each player will pay a \$10 fee to help off-set some of the expenses associated with maintaining the fields.

- Community Building Update
 - We'd like to thank the local AA groups for their donation, as well as the Girls Algoma Little League team for the donation of a double first base for Peterson Park.
- Parks Update:
 - Mike Salzsieder will start replacing the overhead door at the concession building at Peterson Park to make it safer and easier to open.

- Committee discussed taking down the power to the old warming shelter at Newman Park. Robertson will reach out to the Middle School Football coaches to see if there is a need for them to use the shelter for storage.
- Crescent Beach Update:
 - Robertson and Salzsieder are almost done painting all the signs for Crescent Beach. Rules and regulation signs will be made this month.
 - Friends of Crescent Beach will be donating a utility cart to help with garbage removal from the boardwalk. They will also be looking into adding more garbage and recycling containers.
 - NOAA held a listening session at Knudson Hall on March 13th and it was very well attended. NOAA will still be accepting emails and calls for support of the inclusion of Kewaunee County to the Lake Michigan National Marine Sanctuary.
