The Stateline District of the Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association, in an attempt to create a safe and rewarding soccer opportunity for all the youth in the district, is adopting a ZeroTolerance Policy. This policy will be enforced by every club in the district and the Stateline District Board.

- It is up to each coach to set an example of behavior and each coach is responsible for his or her team's and fan's behavior.**
- Abusive language or behavior from players, coaches or parents will not be tolerated.**
- If a referee must ask for a fan, coach or player to control themselves, they will do so through that team's coach.**
- If the intolerable language or behavior persists after a second warning, the referee may suspend the game and the district board will determine the result of the game.**
- Any warnings of poor sportsmanship will be reported on the game report by the referee.**
