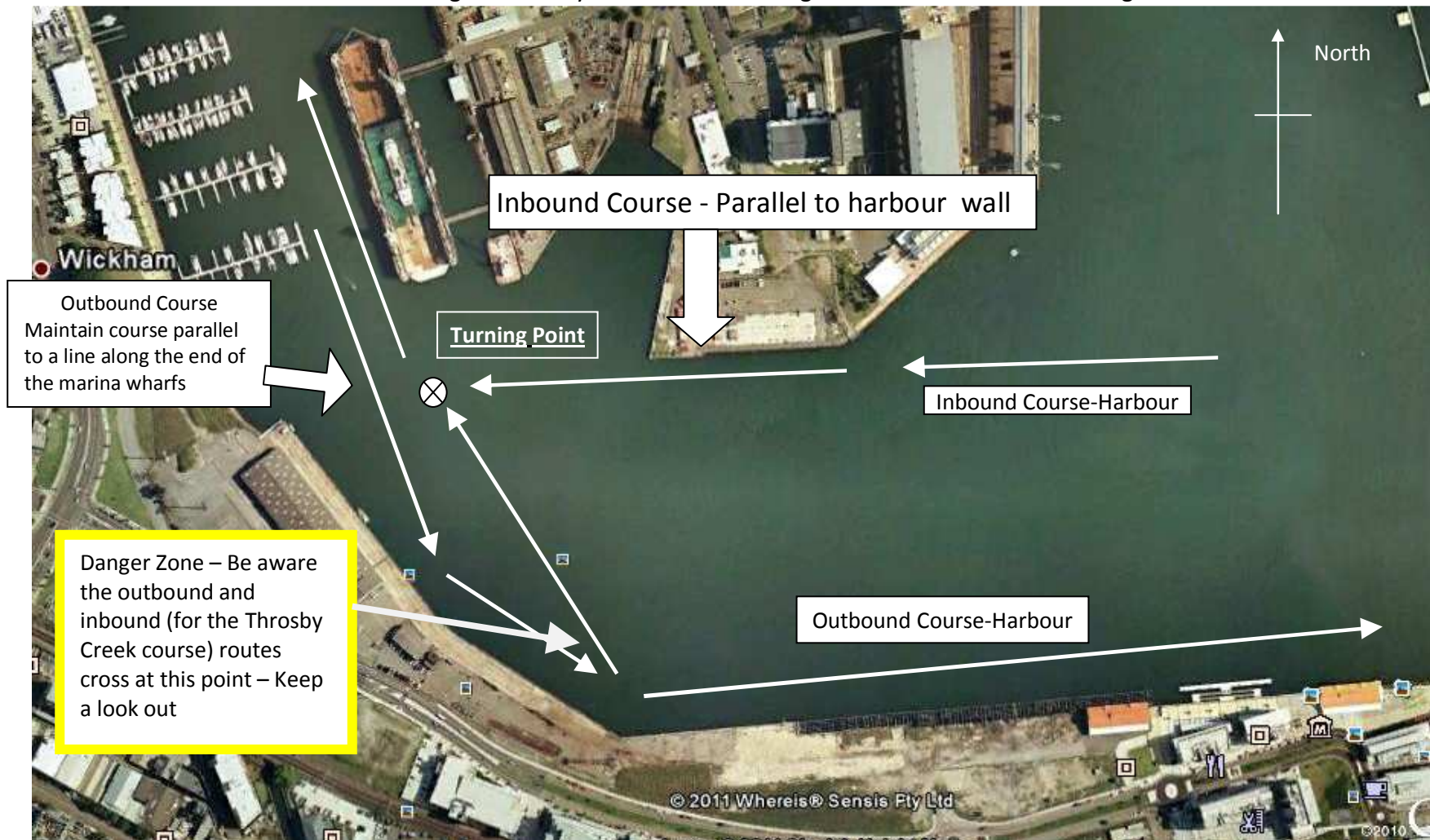


Newcastle Rowing Club Safety Notice - The Floating Dock Corner and Safe Turning Point



The Floating Dock Corner is a blind corner for boats returning from the harbour. To ensure you can see around the corner before turning it is required you remain parallel to the harbour edge till the **Turning Point** is reached. The **Turning Point** is the point where you can see around the corner of the floating dock whilst your course remains parallel to the harbour wall as indicated. By approaching as described it enables any power boat cutting the corner to see you and you them.

Also note the crossing of the outbound and inbound route for rowers using the Throsby Creek Course. A potential hazard exists for rowers where a boat using this training course has turned at the southern wall of the harbour ready to return to the top of Throsby Creek crossing paths with an outbound boat using the same course or intending to head further out into the harbour.
