# CLERGY COLLEAGUE CASE STUDY GROUP

To Begin September, 2013

For the last three years, Fresh Aire Samaritan Counseling Center has sponsored a Clergy Colleague Case Study Group designed to offer clergy a safe and supportive group of peers who meet to discuss issues related to leadership and ministry in the congregational setting.

Participants take turns presenting case studies of difficult situations in their ministerial setting, which require their leadership. Case presentation and discussion follows a structured format in order to dialogue around the various theological, leadership, relational, emotional, and organizational issues raised by each case.

Because of the increased interest, this year Fresh Aire will be offering two different groups to be co-facilitated by Rev. Dr. Lisa McIlvenna, Licensed Professional Counselor and Rev. Dr. Carl Gillett, Spiritual Life Coach. Both have significant training and experience working with clergy and congregations.

There is no cost for being a part of the group. One group will meet in Bay City at the First Presbyterian Church (805 Center Avenue). It will be held on the **third Monday** of each month from 10 am – 12 pm, September through June. A second group, will be meeting in Midland at the First United Methodist Church (315 W. Larkin Street) on the **first Thursday** of each month from 10 am – 12 pm September through June. Participants may sign up for whichever group best fits their schedule.
