The RPCN Community Dentistry Program (CDP) is a program through RPCN Rushville Community Health Center that has been providing school-based dental services since 1995. The program focuses on prevention and education in non-fluoridated areas in New York State and those underserved by dental providers. If you do not have a dentist or dental insurance—or if it is difficult for you to keep appointments due to transportation, work schedule, or a lack of funds, CDP can provide your child with much needed dental services.

School-based dental programs are one of the most efficient ways to reach children and their parents. During the 2010/2011 school year alone, we educated more than 30,000 students across an eight county area in New York. Each student receives a free dental screening, toothbrush, and floss. The CDP team will also teach your child how to floss and brush their teeth the right way, what snacks are healthiest, and how plaque and the decay process happen. Other services that you, as the parent/guardian, may request are:

- Dental exam by a pediatric dentist
- Dental cleaning
- Fluoride treatment
- Dental sealants (if recommended)

Is my child eligible for this program?

Every child enrolled in a participating school is entitled to receive CDP services and education.

How do I enroll my child in the CDP program? The school nurse has the permission forms for CDP. In order to treat your child, we will need you to complete this form and note which services you would like your child to receive. We will also need you to complete a health history form for your child because the health of your mouth is directly related to your overall wellness.

What do we set up in a school?

OUR PORTABLE DENTAL SERVICES ARE ABLE TO QUICKLY ESTABLISH AN ONSITE DENTAL CLINIC COMPLETE WITH:

- Dental chair and light
- Dental unit outfitted with a compressor, air and water outputs, and a high velocity evacuation system, which is the suction device used to remove debris and liquids from the mouth
- Sterilization equipment and other supplies

What if my child needs follow-up care?

If your child needs follow-up dental care and you do not already have a dentist, they can become a patient at any one of our Community Health Center, CDP's home base. In fact, we can treat your entire family for all your primary care and dental needs.

Have insurance?

Don't have insurance? We can help.

Through the RPCN Health Program, RPCN is able to offer patients who don't have insurance or don't have enough insurance. This program is a sliding fee scale based on your current household income.
