SATURDAY AFTERNOON BREAK-OUT SESSIONS

Each Disciples Woman will have the opportunity to attend 2 sessions.

“Live, Laugh, Love & Be Happy,” Rev. Alice Hupp (Session #1 & #2)

In a world filled with news stories of disasters, shootings and political unrest, where do we find respite and renewal? In this session we will be spending some time learning how to center and focus on that which gives us life and energy and peace. Come in comfy clothes and be prepared to laugh and discover how laughter helps to overcome the difficulties of life.

“The Christ-Centered Prayer: An Introduction to Contemplative Prayer,” Nancy Goodman-Gill (Session #1 & #2)

Whether you’ve meditated before or not, you are welcome to this session. This introduction to The Christ Centered Prayer will allow for a deep resting in and with the Christ of your Being. Come and be renewed.

“Spiritual Journaling: Benefits and Tips,” Rev. Linda Barnette (Session #1)

During this session, Linda Couser Barnette, Associate Minister at Richland Hills Christian Church, Brite Divinity Graduate as of May 2018, and an avid journaler since her teens, will share her experiences as a journaler, a bit of her testimony, and discuss topics such as: protecting your privacy; entrance meditations; dates, times, reviewing; telling the truth; your experiences and life events matter; verses, words, quotes, books, friendships, trips, interactions, music that feeds your soul; expressing emotions; journaling as prayer; and much more.

“Personalizing Your Journal,” Rev. Linda Barnette (Session #2)

During Linda’s 2nd session you will have the opportunity to create/embellish a journal (supplies provided) in a unique way. You will receive some materials to help you with your “Journaling with God.” This session will be limited to 25 participants (first to register). *There will be a \$5 fee to be paid at the session.*

“Creative Craft,” Mary Chris Gibbons (Session #1 & #2)

Mary Chris Gibbons, an avid crafter, will guide you in this session as you create an amazing craft. Each participant will make a braided necklace featuring heart pendants. The session will take place during both break-out times and each session will be limited to 20 participants (first to register).

CCSW DISCIPLES WOMEN'S ASSEMBLY HANDS-ON MISSION/OUTREACH

The Disciples Women's current mission project is "Blessing Bags" which can be a tangible expression of God's love both to us and to the ones we are blessing. Items should fit into a one-gallon zip-lock bag. At our Women's Assembly at the Radisson Hotel, Fort Worth North at Fossil Creek on June 22 -24, 2018, our hands-on mission/outreach will be "Blessing Bags" for the Women and Children's Facility of the Presbyterian Night Shelter of Fort Worth.

The Presbyterian Night Shelter was begun by a group of Presbyterian ministers as an overnight shelter for the county's homeless population. Today they retain many of the elements that gave them their name, providing (but not requiring) spiritual guidance for those who seek it through a full-time Chaplain and the Hope Chapel for Bible study and worship. And while their emergency shelter services are still available to anyone who needs them, they are equally focused on helping their guest find their own permanent housing. Their campus includes a shelter that houses homeless adults, with separate facilities for families (women and children), veterans and those with behavioral disabilities.

The Women and Children's Facility

Their women and Children's Facility is the only shelter in Fort Worth that allows families with older teenage boys to remain with their mothers, keeping the families together. They also provide a comprehensive children's program, which includes playgrounds, on-site counseling, and after-school tutoring.

You have the option of preparing a "Blessing Bag" for a woman (mother), a child, or a teenager. Items to include in a one-gallon zip-lock bag:

- Travel size hand sanitizer 2.5/3 oz. (\$.97 or \$1)
- Lotion 2 oz. size (\$1.47 Walmart or \$1 Dollar Tree)
- Sun screen (for Child: sun screen stick at Walmart \$2 – for Teen: sports tube \$1 at Dollar Tree)
(for the Woman: 3-oz tube Equate Beauty SPF 55 \$4.47 Walmart)
- Kleenex(s) pocket size (8 in pkg. at Dollar Tree)
- Tooth Brush Kit (\$.97 to \$1.47 Walmart)
- Fruit Bars/Cheese Crackers/Individual Snack Packets (Gold Fish, etc.)

For a **child** you might also include a Little Golden story book or similar or 8-ct. box of crayons and small size coloring book (must fit in a 1-gallon zip-lock bag).

For a **teenager** you could include a puzzle book or paper back novel.

For **the woman** a small devotional book and a First Aid to Go Kit (Walmart \$.97)

Please label your bag (Woman; Child; or Teen) and include a Bible Verse or a Note of Encouragement.
