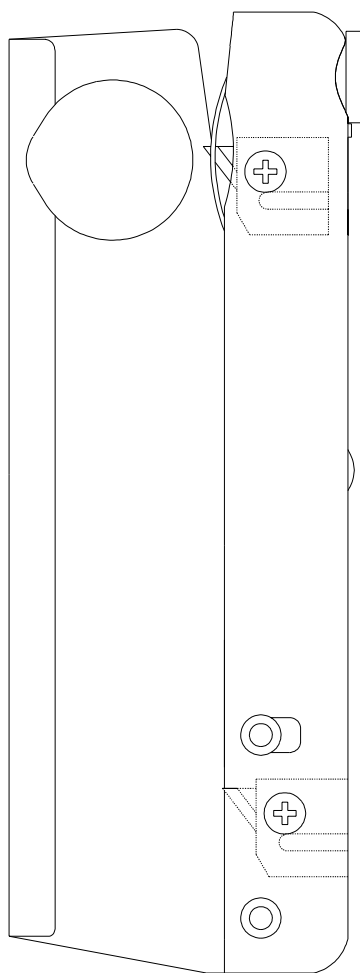

USER INSTRUCTIONS STRIP-ALL® SA-200L

ALL MODELS MADE IN U.S.A.

WARNING: Never attempt to strip energized cables since any contact between a live wire and ground can be lethal

TO STRIP CABLES:

Always make a trial cut to check blade depth

- 1) Measure or estimate cable jacket thickness. Most cable's jackets are .020" to .040" thick.
- 2) Zero Blade depth by turning Dial a CW until Index Pointer b reads 0
- 3) Turn Dial a CCW to set desired stripping depth. One turn equals .020" (1/2mm) blade penetration. For NM make one turn and continue to the triangle mark.
- 4) Place end of cable in Cable Guide f. Squeeze Strip-All to pierce cable jacket and pull out while applying light downward pressure.
- 5) Adjust Dial a as needed to prevent nicking of insulated wires.

TO CHANGE BLADE CARTRIDGE:

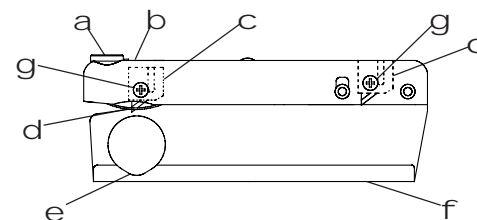
Remove Retaining Screw g and tap out Blade Cartridge c and replace. B-202 Blade



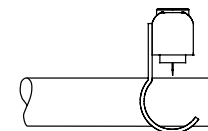










- a Dial - Blade Depth

RING-CUT: Place the cable in **Ring-Cut Vee e** push top housing down & turn cable or tool around. Then make a straight cut along the cable and peel off jacket. (heavy jackets might require the use of pliers to remove)

 FT-210		"HINGENIOUS" FISH TAPE PULLER: The FT-210 has a patented cam gripping action, the more you pull the more it grabs! Two handed action for twice the pulling force. Much safer than using pliers while preventing kinks and damage to the fish-tape.

 VT-270	NEW!	Vee-Twin: Often the only option for difficult rubber and plastic jacketed cables is to use a knife. This is time consuming, inaccurate, and can lead to injuries. This is where the Vee-Twin steps in, it will easily and precisely strip the jacket on these cables. Works great on cables from 5/16 to 2-1/8" O.D. It is easy to adjust, safe to use, and can fit into difficult to reach locations. Strip in place, even around curved cables!
