

COURT RULES

No weapons of any type allowed in the Court or Lobby.

Due to increased security procedures you should arrive 20-30 minutes prior to your scheduled court appearance to allow for check-in.

If you arrive after court has begun you will be asked to leave and required to pay a rescheduling fee and return to court on another date.

For the safety of all persons in the court, all persons and their belongings are subject to search prior to entering the court.

If you fail to appear for your court date a Bench Warrant may be issued and additional fines or penalties may be imposed

Cell phones, pagers and electronic communications equipment are not permitted in the courtroom or lobby.

No hats or sunglasses are to be worn during court.

No gum chewing, food or drink in the courtroom.

Proper attire must be worn in the courtroom.

No T shirts with alcohol, tobacco, nor drug related logos.

No inappropriate language will be permitted.

Noise from conversation, children, etc. must be kept to a minimum, or you will be asked to leave the courtroom.

Please bring your citation and any related documents regarding your case with you.

Remember this is a New Mexico Court of Law, un-truthful testimony is Perjury which is a Felony and may be charged as such.

Please respect all parties right to be heard and only speak when it is your turn as indicated by the Judge
