§ 14.2.1 PURPOSE

Village roads and streets are not designed, suitable or constructed for heavy truck traffic. In order to maintain the safety, health, prosperity, order, comfort, and convenience of the Village, it is necessary to regulate the operation of trucks and commercial vehicles within the Village limits.

§ 14.2.2 PROHIBITED VEHICLES

(A) VEHICLES OVER FIVE TONS. No person or entity shall operate or cause to be operated any truck or commercial vehicle having a load capacity in excess of five (5) tons on any street or road within the Village limit, excepting Rio Grande Boulevard and El Pueblo Road, and except for local deliveries and services, unless a permit is obtained from the Mayor.

(B) VEHICLES OVER TWO TONS. No person or entity shall operate or cause to be operated any truck or commercial vehicle having a load capacity in excess of two (2) tons on any street or road within the Village limits, excepting Rio Grande Boulevard and El Pueblo Road, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., and except for local deliveries and services, unless a permit is obtained from the Mayor.
