

Los Ranchos Master Plan Public Input Meeting Schedule & Topics

- **October 16, 2018: Agriculture**

This meeting will focus on agriculture and its current and possible role in the Village's identity, culture, economy, housing, and land use decisions.

- **November 7, 2018: Environment**

This meeting will focus on availability and maintenance of open space and greenery, habitat, ditches, water, and air/lighting/water pollution and quality in the Village and how it relates to land use, property rights, and quality of life.

- **December 4, 2018: Community Facilities & Services**

This meeting will focus on the Village's community facilities and services and how it relates to land use, quality of life, and recreation. This covers amenities and facilities including but not limited to fire and police (emergency services), education (schools), electricity, water, infrastructure (eg. Internet, cell service), parks, libraries, and community centers. Cost and maintenance of these facilities will also be discussed. For those facilities and services not provided by or in the Village, provider relationship and proximity to facilities and services will be discussed.

- **January 15, 2019: Residential Development & Community**

This meeting will focus on the residents and community in the Village and various aspects that affect the quality of life, in particular addressing multigenerational vitality. The focus is on housing and services for residents, including infrastructure and character areas, and the role of the Village and land use in it all.

- **March 19, 2019: Historic Preservation & Culture***

This meeting will focus on the history and heritage of the Village, aspects to be preserved and/or highlighted, and possibilities on how to do so. Historic and cultural assets and character, such as historic places, archeology, and historic lot patterns (tripas) will be addressed through a land use lens, in particular addressing this preservation on private property and how to unify the Village's historic character.

- **March 19, 2019: Transportation***

This meeting will focus on the Village and surrounding area's transportation system, including vehicles and alternative modes of transportation (by foot, bicycle, public transit). This will look at how transportation connects the other elements previously discussed and the relationship between transportation and those elements. Such aspects include the relationship between transportation and recreation and transportation and noise.

- **April 16, 2019: Economic Development – RESCHEDULED**

This meeting will focus on the current and potential business climate of the Village to address commercial land use, businesses, tourism, technology and infrastructure, and the Village's financial health and tax base.
