



Larry P. Abraham Agri-Nature Center Improvements

Utility Improvements on Schedule to reopen Rio Grande Blvd. on July 10th

Bradbury Stamm Construction began the project to connect water, sewer, and fire suppression lines to the Agri-Nature Center on June 29, 2020. The Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (ABCWUA) water and sewer utility lines are located in the roadway of Rio Grande Blvd., directly in front of the driveway to the Agri-Nature Center, necessitating the road closure to connect a six-inch fire protection line, a 2-inch domestic water line, and a six-inch sewer line. The sewer and water connections will take place on Monday, July 6th and should not result in any service disruptions in the area.

The phase of construction on Rio Grande Blvd. is on schedule to be complete by Friday, July 10th with the roadway reopening by 5pm. Subsequent construction phases will occur on the Agri-Nature Center property and no further traffic disruptions are anticipated. A contract has been awarded to Bradbury Stamm in the amount of \$126,000.00 to complete the work by July 31, 2020.
