Trailblazers are welcome to stay on Thursdays until 9 p.m. and participate in our candlelight ceremony free of charge. Additionally the Week 7 (August 10) Overnight Experience is included free of charge.

Teen Camp - \$420/week - Ages 13 to 14

Teens have a leisurely start to the day with breakfast at 9 a.m., but activities go until late at night. During the day the teens and two counselors participate in a variety of supervised activities. These activities include many of the usual programs but also include Laser Tag, Sniper Trail and Tripods where the teens choose from 3 activities and can stay as long as they want or switch activities. The boys and the girls are together and encouraged to socialize and they are always supervised. At certain times during the week the entire camp comes together for dances, lip-syncs and the ever-popular Beach Party. The evening program allows teens to plan their own campfire and skit-night and provides the famous Scully Dance. The week is rounded off with our ever-popular Candlelight Ceremony.

Campers are on the go from 7 a.m. to late at night. During the day the ten campers and two staff participate in a variety of structured, scheduled activities. These activities include swimming, fort-building, sports, crafts, archery, team building, arts, canoeing, kayaking, cooking, challenge course, aquatic and field games. There are also Skill Clinics for campers to choose from, specifically designed for participants to progressively build skills in their chosen activity. At certain times during the week the entire camp comes together for theme week activities, predator/prey, carnivals, Radio Scully and the ever-popular Beach Party. Our varied evening program introduces campers to the forest and stars at night, entertains them at campfire and skit-night and provides the famous Scully Dance. The week is rounded off with our Candlelight Ceremony. **Weekly Sessions from June 25 to Aug 4.**

Leaders In Training - Age 15 - \$400 Counselors In Training - Age 16 - Free

LIT's spend their weeks with their peers in team-building exercises and growth activities designed to improve leadership and work skills. Lots of time will be spent on our challenge course and with our boats and raft-building. CIT's are placed directly with the campers for hands-on learning. Under the supervision of the CIT director and the counselors, a CIT has a complete experience of what it takes to be a Scully counselor.
