

Bus Transportation FAQs:

Which bus will my child ride?

The bus that passes nearest to your residence.

What time will my child be picked up?

The bus driver will determine approximate time of pick-up after the first week of school.

Where will my child be picked up?

The bus driver will establish stops after the first week of school. These stops will always be on the corners, not the middle of the block.

Will my child have to switch buses and where?

If your child is not an elementary student that lives in town they will all be transported to the high school where they will get on their route buses.

If my child misses the bus what do I do?

It is your responsibility to find transportation for your child to school.

Who can I contact to report any problems?

Contact the warehouse at 235-4181.

What are the consequences for any misbehavior on the bus?

Consequences could be visiting with the principal to determine disciplinary action, as well as, possible loss of bus privileges.

Is there any supervision at the High School when students are switching buses?

There will be bus monitors from each school at the high school every afternoon to help ensure safety while switching buses.

How do I become a bus driver?

Contact the warehouse (235-4181) to get started.

How often do I have to attend bus certification classes

There is an initial 20-hour class and an 8-hour re-certification class that you must attend yearly.

What happens if I miss my annual 8-hour certification class?

There is a process of emergency certification which must be completed upon the expiration of your certification should you miss the class. The class has to be taken within a year of expiration or you must take the 20-hour class again.

How much does it cost to get my CDL?

The initial cost of the CDL is \$60.00, which will be reimbursed upon the completion of your training.
