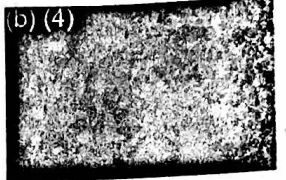
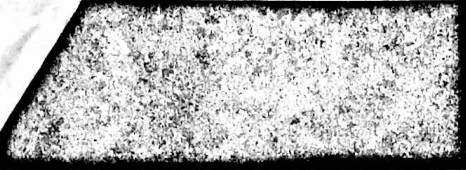

Dear Mr. Rabe,

This letter is on behalf of our client, Shur-Green Farms, LLC ("Shur-Green") and is in response to the warning letter dated April 24, 2015. Shur-Green takes regulatory compliance extremely seriously and is committed to addressing your concerns adequately and expeditiously.

On October 23, 2014, and with the assistance of your agency, Shur-Green undertook a voluntary recall of all outstanding loads of the product at issue in your warning letter. Please find attached to this letter a copy of the press released in connection with this recall.

Shur-Green has ceased selling the products which were the subject of the recall, and will not sell these products again in the future. As a result, we feel that the issues raised in in your warning letter are largely moot. Although Shur-Green does not admit any fault or that any violation of the Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act has occurred, it is, nevertheless, committed to continuing to improve its business practices and adhering to the highest standards of industry conduct. Your thoughts and suggestions as to how Shur-Green can improve its compliance with and commitment to FDA regulations going forward would be welcomed and greatly appreciated.
