

Stashbuster Scarf



Skill Level	Size	Measurements	Gauge	Materials
Beginner	One size	5" by 60" or desired length	Gauge is not important to this project	Small amounts of many colors and textures of yarn. Size US15 needles

Instructions:

Arrange your balls of yarn in a gradient of colors before you begin. Here is where you can have fun! You can arrange all of your colors in one long gradient or you can limit the color palette and repeat the gradient multiple times.

Beginning at one end of your graded balls of yarn, use 2 strands together and CO 18 sts.

R1: Kfb, K to last 2 sts, K2tog. Cut one color leaving a tail of about 12 inches. Add next color, leaving a tail of about 12 inches.

R2: K across.

Continue by repeating these 2 rows and changing colors according to the gradient you laid out until piece measures the desired length. BO all stitches.

Knot the tails along the side of the scarf either as straight fringe, or in a more macramé design.

KEY

CO = cast on

Kfb = knit into the front of the stitch but do not drop the stitch from the left needle, then insert the tip of the right needle into the back of the stitch and knit it off the left needle.

K = knit

K2tog = knit 2 stitches together

BO = bind off

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
