Sports Day Reminders

The opening ceremony will begin just after 9am. Parents and friends are welcomed to attend throughout the day. Adults please remain outside the oval fenced area during the opening and closing ceremony. At other times you may follow your child's class to various events..

A reminder that there will be very limited food available for adults on the day. Students will be eating lunch in their classrooms before a short outside play time.

The closing ceremony is expected to be underway by 2:30pm.

If students are taken home at any time during the day, parents are to see the child's teacher and sign the student out.

Dogs

Please remember that dogs are NOT to be on school grounds at any time. The only exception with this is a negotiation with classroom teacher for a sharing/morning talk time. If this does occur the dog must remain on the lead and leave immediately after the talk.

Time on school grounds

Before school

Students are NOT to be onsite before 8:20am as this is when yardsupervision starts.

Learning time starts at 8.55am. The optimum time to arrive at school is between 8.35am and 8.45am.

On arrival at school, students wait near their classroom door or play until the door is unlocked by the teacher and they are invited to enter the room. This is at approx 8.50am.

School finishes at 3.15pm

The school day ends at 3.15pm. The school grounds are supervised until 3.35pm (when the school bus leaves).

Children are welcomed and encouraged to use the play equipment after school BUT only if their parents or a designated adult is supervising. The playground is not designed for adult use and this can cause a hazard when children are using.

Parents who have work or other commitments that make them unable to collect their children after school need to make arrangements for the care of their children from 3.15pm such as POSCH 0407 490 149.
