Each woman has her own story, needs and strengths. We know that there is no one "right way" to heal, and our diverse programming aims to meet women where they are and to accompany them on their journey. Our Sister Circle Program, for example, is now regarded as a cornerstone community resource for Black women. Our Challenge into Change program spreads our belief in healing and transformation and reduces mental health stigma for an ever-expanding audience. In 2018 we continued efforts to lower barriers to care such as expanding our walk-in clinics to five days a week and adding new group offerings in our Bienestar Program for Latina women.

In 2018 we also strived to support healing at the community level, particularly as Charlottesville faced the first anniversary of the white

supremacist violence of August 11-12, 2017. Our staff worked tirelessly to provide more care and a sense of accessible support during a difficult time. We also collaborated with local leaders to build community resilience through mental health trainings and a public awareness campaign.

Our agency focuses on serving women from low-income households, the Latino and African American communities, survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault victims and their families, the LBTQ+ community, and our emerging immigrant and refugee populations. We recognize that the struggles all women face in accessing effective mental health care are made even more difficult for minorities because of historic and ongoing oppression that contribute to individuals feeling isolated, misunderstood and alone. Our agency works to break down these barriers.




