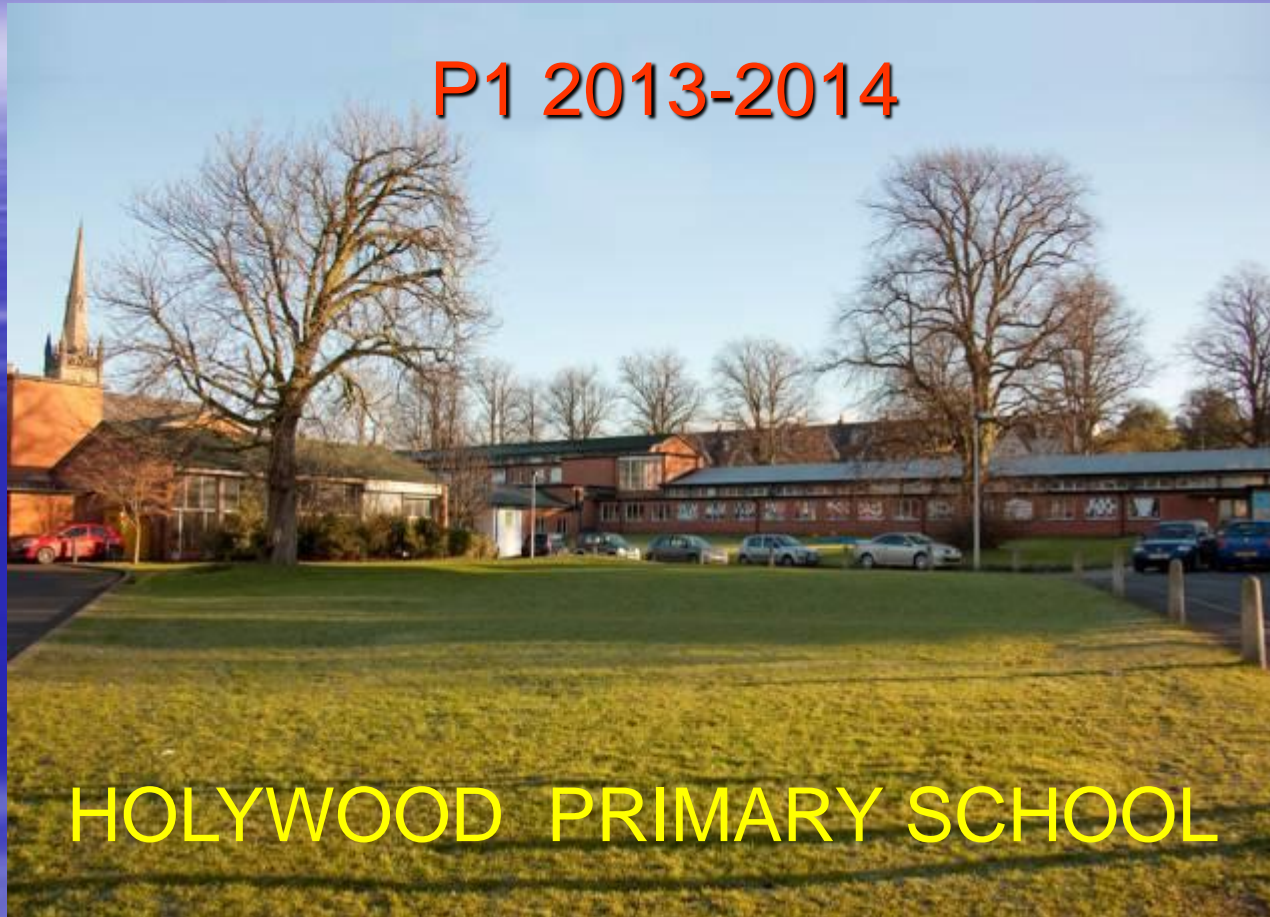

Timetable **Term 1**



P1 children go to their classroom between 8.45 a.m. and 8.55 a.m.
The boys and girls go home at 12.15pm during September and October.

From November the children stay until **2 p.m.**

Primary school is special

Each day talk to your child about their day.

They tend to talk more freely after unwinding!



Term 2 & 3



In the morning P1 children go directly into the P1 & P2 playground. A member of staff will be on duty between **8.45 a.m.** and **8.55 a.m.**

At the end of each day children are released to an known adult...

- Initially at the classroom door
- At the end of the corridor
- Outside either at the front path

Eventually the children are escorted to the **front gate** of the school.

Parents/guardians/childminders collect the children from the teacher each day.

After School Club for P1 – P3 pupils between 2 p.m. and 2.50 p.m.

e.g. art, craft, model making, music, educational games,
imaginative play and outdoor play (weather permitting!)

The 1,2,3 After School Club has limited places each day and costs £3 per session.

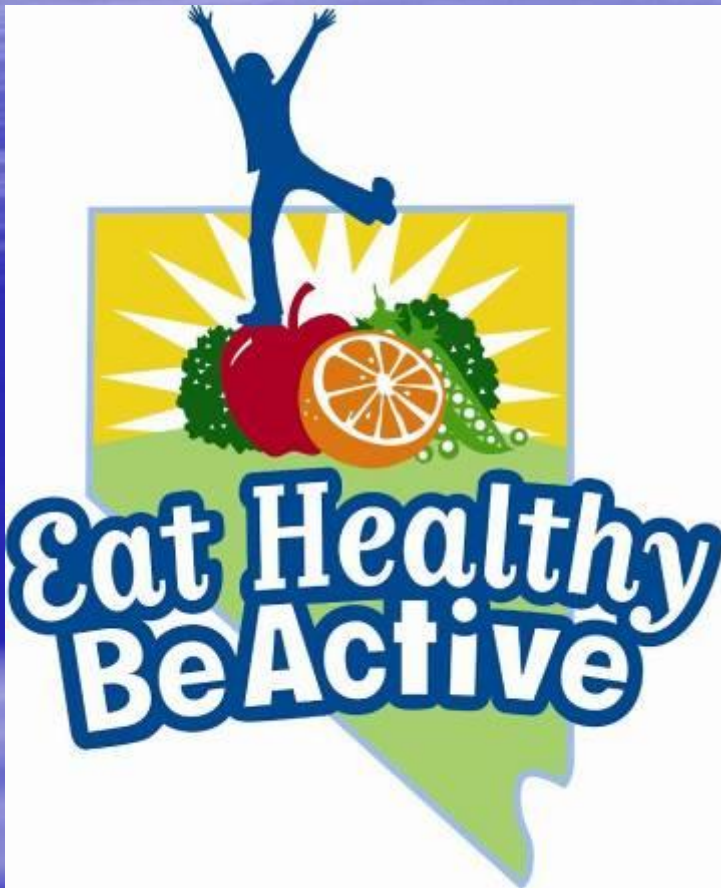
The Club is run by Mrs Martin who is a member of the school staff.

If your child is unwell please only send them back to school when they have fully recovered.

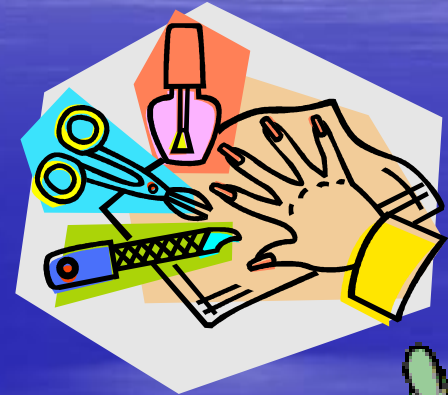


When your child returns to school please send a written explanation about their absence. We need this for DENI records.

- After half term the first of two Parent / Teacher Consultations in the P1 year specifically about your child's progress and areas for development.
