Jim Dalton and Maggi Smith-Dalton perform music of popular folk and cultivated traditions—covering time periods from the Middle Ages to the present, with a focus on American and Celtic repertoire. They specialize in 19th and 20th century music from parlor and stage, often including historical commentary in their performances. Jim Dalton is a faculty member of the Boston Conservatory, conductor and award-winning composer and arranger. An accomplished singer and guitarist, Maggi Smith-Dalton authored two books of history and holds a master’s degree in American Studies. The duo has released two recordings to date, co-authored, “The Measure of the Year—Singing Through the Seasons” and have performed in many national venues, including Colonial Williamsburg, Seneca Falls, the Harriet Beecher Stowe House.

The Second Sunday Concert Series at Boston Sculptors Gallery presents a monthly collaboration with Boston area musicians, programmed by Music Director Aaron Jay Myers. The musicians are often inspired by the sculpture on display and perform interactive works in response to it. All events are free and open to the public and donations directly support the musicians.
