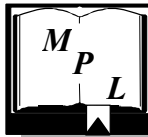

Lesson Seven: The Bible—Human and Divine

Day One

Read Luke 24:25–27, 44–45.

According to these verses, what is another name for the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms? **The Scriptures**

Read 2 Peter 3:14–16.

According to this passage, what is another name for Paul's writings? **Scriptures (letters)**

Day Two

Read Deuteronomy 8:1–5 and Matthew 4:1–4.

On what should people live? **On every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord**

Read 2 Timothy 3:16–17.

Who is the source of all Scripture? **God**

Day Three

Read John 10:31–36.

According to verse 35, what is another name for the Word of God? **Scripture**

What do you think it means that the Scriptures “cannot be set aside?”

That one cannot believe some sections and not others

Day Four

Read Numbers 23:19 and Titus 1:2.

What do these verses say God cannot do? **Lie**

Read John 17:17.

According to Jesus, what is God's Word? **Truth**

Day Five

Read Jeremiah 1:1–4.

Through whom did God speak? **Jeremiah (a prophet)**

Read Amos 1:1–8.

Through whom did God speak? **Amos (a shepherd)**

Day Six

Read 2 Peter 1:20–21.

Who is the source of Scripture? **God**

Through whom did God speak? **Prophets**

What did God do to cause men to write His Word?

They were “carried along by the Holy Spirit”
