



## 2018 Rump Run Volunteer Information

Thank you all for supporting the Rump Run event to raise money and awareness for colon cancer in and around Chattanooga! I wanted to share some information with you to hopefully answer any questions you may have as we get closer to the event. Of course, if you have further questions or need clarification, please don't hesitate to let me know.

**Event Information:** Registration: 7:30 – 8:50, Survivor Recognition: 8:50, Timed 5K: 9:00, Fun Walk: 9:30, Awards: 10:00

**Parking:** Designated parking for volunteers will be available in the Volkswagen lot near the closest roundabout to Enterprise South Nature Park. This lot is located in front of the VW Academy - please follow the signs for participant and volunteer/survivor parking. From this parking location, you can either walk the short distance to the event site, or ride the available shuttle, which will begin running at 6:30 am.

*From I-75 -Take Exit #9, Volkswagen Drive. The Visitor's Center and Park entrance is the first right at the first roundabout, though this entrance will be closed to cars. To park, take the 3rd right in the roundabout and continue on Volkswagen Drive, and follow signs for volunteer parking. The Volkswagen parking lot can be entered by taking the first right at the next roundabout. Park in the Volkswagen lot near the Enterprise South Nature Park in front of Volkswagen Academy.*

*From Bonny Oaks Drive -Take Volkswagen Drive at the main entrance to Enterprise South, and follow signs for volunteer parking. Go through the roundabout at Amazon and continue on Volkswagen Drive. At the next roundabout, take the third right into the Volkswagen entrance and park in the Volkswagen lot near Enterprise South Nature Park in front of Volkswagen Academy.*

**Volunteer Check In:** When you enter the park, you will see the Visitor's Center a little way in on the hill to your right. Please go into that building to the Volunteer Check In area, which will be located in the front room. There, you will receive your volunteer t-shirt, as well as instructions for the area in which you are volunteering.

**Time Requirements:** The time requirements vary based upon the position for which you have volunteered.

- **Parking** – You will NOT check in at the Visitor's Center; instead, you will meet Dr. Marshall Horton in the Volkswagen lot at 6:45. Plan to be there until 9:00. It may be chilly that early in the morning – make sure you plan to bring a coat and gloves.
- **Race Course Marshalls and Water Stop** – Check in at 7:45, and plan to be on the course until the Fun Walk concludes at 10:00. You may want to bring a chair to sit in while waiting for the race to begin.
- **Registration** – Check in at 7:00, and plan to be there until the race begins at 9:00
- **First Aid** – Check in at 7:30, and plan to be there until the event concludes around 10:30
- **Kid's Zone** – Check in at 7:00 and plan to be there until the event concludes around 10:30
- **Post Race Refreshment** – Check in at 8:30 and plan to be there until the event concludes around 10:30
- **Survivor Tent** – Check in at 7:30 and plan to be there until the event concludes around 10:30
- **Goody Bags** – Check in at 8:30 and plan to be there until after the Fun Walk concludes at 10:00
- **Clean Up Crew** – Check in at 8:30 and plan to be there until after the event concludes. You should be there no later than 11:30.

We are looking forward to a fun, successful event next weekend! We appreciate you partnering with us to bring colon cancer awareness to our community!
