A four session dynamic abstract "collage work out" for students (beginner to advanced) who would like to pump up their mixed media repertoire with exciting, colorful, creative approaches to making contemporary art. This pop up course will begin the process of transforming participants into more confident and invigorated collage artists. During (4) three hour sessions, we will cover the nuts and bolts of working in layers, using textures, color, line and always evaluating the elements of design. Students will also learn about disturbing, interrupting, camouflaging, cropping, embellishing and cutting up and reassembling work that goes AWOL. Class critiques will be included. A small materials fee will be collected.
