Our Partnership:

In the 21st century, we realize that God is calling all of us to be engaged in God's work in the world as the Spirit moves us and provides opportunities. The Kentucky Baptist Fellowship makes it possible for Kentucky Baptist congregations to be involved in world-wide ministry through our sister relationship with the Eglise Evangélique au Maroc (Protestant Church in Morocco). Since 2006, KBF congregations have been living our Christian unity and calling to achieve God's purpose in full partnership with congregations and ministries of the EEAM, breaking down barriers, bridging gaps, and crossing divides of age, ethnicity, language, culture, nationality, economics, and geography for the glory of God and the building up of the body of Christ.

What it takes to be a Congregational Partner:

- 1) Willingness to get organized locally & invest in an ongoing congregational relationship with a congregation or ministry in Morocco (setting up a partnership team, getting the team to lead the entire congregation to be involved);
- 2) Learning about your partners in Morocco and their Moroccan/African context and taking the time to share with your partners your own congregational story and work;
- 2) A commitment to communication across barriers: Establishing and pursuing communication with your partners in Morocco AND keeping your own congregation informed of news and activities in creative ways;
- 3) Organizing joint activities like joint ministry projects on both sides of the ocean, joint Bible studies, joint worship services (using live technology or pre-recorded contributions);
- 4) Praying for your partners in Morocco;
- 5) Supporting your partners in Morocco financially (\$100/month or more requested for a church partnership);
- 6) Being connected as much as possible – organizing visits in both directions, skyping, facebooking.
