## *Frequently Asked Questions*

**How much does it cost?** Each league determines its weekly fees at the league's organizational meeting. 2016-2017 fees were \$20 per bowler per week. A portion of league fees is prize fund contribution. Bowlers joining a USBC sanctioned league for the summer season must join USBC (United States Bowling Congress) Dues are \$11 and must be renewed for the fall season (\$19 annually).

**What if I miss a week?** All of our leagues either allow teams to have additional bowlers on their team roster or allow for substitutes to take your place for that week.

**How about practice?** 10 minutes of practice begins at the time stated. League competition follows practice. Bowlers arriving late (after 4th frame has begun) must wait until next game to bowl.

**Do league bowlers get discounts?** Yes, Mondays through Thursdays, excluding holidays.

**Do I have to have a full team to join?** No, your league officers will introduce you to others who are looking for team members.

**What if I don't own bowling shoes?** Rental shoes are available at a discounted rate of \$3.00 plus tax. There is a pro shop on site offering a wide selection of bowling equipment and supplies.
