1. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 8)** - Pray that I would be able to create more genuine relationships with players on the football team and that God would give me chances to share the gospel. Please pray specifically for Ed, a friend on the team. Pray that I would have opportunities to share the gospel with Ed and that he will be open to hearing it.
2. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please pray for Grm, a co-worker in the hospital. Ask that God would give us more opportunities to talk about Jesus. Pray also for Hdwn, a co-worker in the hospital. Ask that God would put questions in his heart about what it means to know HIm.
3. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for us as we host a neighborhood dinner party this month. Pray that we will be able to really connect with neighbors/friends and that we will be able to clearly share the Gospel.
4. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Please pray for our relationships here that we would have many chances to share the gospel.
5. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Please pray for my grandmother. She has recently broken her back and is in a lot of pain. Pray also for a good friend of mine who has lost her brother recently. I wish I could be with them during these difficult times.
6. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Pray for the growth and discipleship of the students in North Wales. Pray that they rely on the Spirit to move through them to build the Kingdom.
7. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 7)** - Please pray for more opportunities to have gospel conversations and build relationships with locals. Pray for me also as I finish university course work and discern future ministry plans.

8. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please pray for me as I'll be sharing from the Word in two Welsh-speaking chapels in the area.
9. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - The bible study that we have started with the youth is going very well. One of the students has begun to facilitate the whole thing. Pray that the other guys will feel comfortable enough to talk and eventually lead themselves.
10. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for our outreaches into local art classes. We have been able to share our faith in one of our classes (the whole class) two weeks in a row now. Pray that God would work in their hearts. Pray that they might be able to see His goodness and grace and their need for forgiveness.
11. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Please pray for health problems in our family.
12. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Pray for opportunities for girls bible study, led by local girls.
13. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - This month hits my longest time in another culture at one time. I am expecting to have a different kind of culture shock as I cross the 6-month mark.
14. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - A young Welsh friend of ours, Kim, who is a believer, is experiencing A LOT of rejection from home in relation to her faith. Please pray for her strength and for the love of Christ to spread in her family.
15. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please pray for me as I'll be sharing from the Word during the morning and evening in Eglwysbach
16. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please pray for us as we make the final preparations in the Mission-Net Conference in Germany over the New Year.
17. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - This month is one of the best months for connecting with local people. Pray that we might be real agents of God's grace during a time when people really open up their homes and families to us.
18. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Please pray for protection against spiritual warfare in our family.
19. Thu - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for several new connecting points we have in the last month. Pray that Thursday nights spent out with the lads discussing life would be impactful, and that the time spent crafting with other ladies would open up new doors to speak Truth into lives.
20. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - This is the last day of our first semester in Welsh language class. Pray for God's grace in listening comprehension, speaking,

writing, and reading comprehension in Cymraeg. We will be studying for an examination in one month as well as beginning a new class in January.

21. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Pray that, if the Lord wills, I will be able to visit a group of friends in South Wales soon. One of them has been showing an interest in God and has Facebook messaged me his thoughts a few times. Please pray that if I do get an opportunity to go there will be rich conversation with Christ at the center.
22. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for our children's friends and classmates. Our children may be the only Christian witness they have.
23. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please pray for JH, a former patient who was a believer. Ask that God would give her a speedy recovery and speak to her through the Word.
24. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Praise Jesus our friend Cameron is officially part of the family! Since his rebirth, he has been taking giant leaps of growth. Without me mentioning it to him, he brought up how he wants to be a tool for the Kingdom and gave me two names of guys in his school he wants to see come to Christ. Amen, am I right!?
25. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for 2 of our children to accept Christ.
26. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for a group of us as we begin our journey to Germany for Mission-Net (www.mission-net.org) in Offenburg.
27. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Pray for us as we continue to adapt to a new culture.
28. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for the Mission-Net Conference, which begins today.
29. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for our language learning and the people we are in class with, that we will be witnesses for the gospel to them.
30. Mon- **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Please pray that our team in Wales will continue to maintain a healthy ethos of community and vulnerability as we work and live together.
