2. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Whereas IMB members of the CeLT are supported, all other CeLT team members have to raise ALL of their own financial support. Please, pray that God will provide all that they need to continue to pursue His vision for the Celtic Languages people groups.
3. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - 1) This month we will host a dinner party with people in our community. Pray that our relationships would deepen. 2) Please continue to pray for our friend who is battling cancer. Pray that we can be a help and comfort to her and her family.
4. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - 1) Our new baby is due any day now. Pray for a healthy mom and baby. 2) Pray for our kids growing up without many strong Christian influences.
5. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Please pray for my father and mother. My dad was diagnosed with Parkinson's last year, and with his condition declining my mom has had to begin taking care of him while also taking care of her parents who are also in bad condition.
6. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Pray that I can find the balance of being present where I am at here in The States, while keeping connections with those back in the UK.
7. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 7)** - Pray for me as I am raising funds to get back on the field.
8. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Continuance of Language learning - in and out of class.

9. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for me as I will be preaching in two different places today (Caernarfon and Eglwysbach).
10. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - 1) Our clubs and classes will be starting back this month. Pray that we will meet new people and deepen the relationships with our already existing friends in these clubs/classes. 2) Please pray that we will find new ways of meeting people and serving our community.
11. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Because of expecting a new baby we've had more interaction with neighbors. Pray for chances to share the Gospel.
12. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 7)** - Pray for opportunities for Gospel conversations with friends.
13. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please continue to pray for Grm, a co-worker in the hospital. A few weeks ago he asked me a question about hope for the world, to which I answered that I thought Jesus was the only hope. His response was 'you just may be right.' This is from a man who was antagonistic about faith in Jesus when I met him 3 years ago.
14. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for two CeLT personnel, who will be flying to California for some mobilization opportunities, including the Global Outreach Celebration at Immanuel Baptist Church in Highland, which has been in partnership with us for many years.
15. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please pray for Cy,a co-worker in the hospital. Ask that God would give her strength for her work and that she would come to know the One who gives strength.
16. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray that more students will respond to our many requests for this summer's projects - We need a lot of students to be involved with a number of different activities.
17. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Pray for our sub-team as we go through a lot of transitions. Pray that we will grow closer as a community and that God would bless our Christian community.
18. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray we can progress well in Irish language studies this year. It's one of our main goals.
19. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for the various connections that were made at Mission-Net in January. We hope that these will produce an interest in European Christians to pray for us and perhaps come and join us in ministry.

20. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Pray for continued grace in language learning. Specifically pray for reading comprehension, writing, hearing, and speaking in Cymraeg.

23. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please pray for a long term patient of mine. Ask that God would speak to her as she remains in hospital and that she would be encouraged by the Holy Spirit in me.

25. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - T is having ongoing tests regarding chronic abdominal pain. Please pray for healing and relief.
26. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 7)** - Pray for me as I speak at churches in the U.S., representing our organization.
