3. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me as I'll be attending a leadership meeting in London.
4. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Mrs. Irish 2 has some ongoing health issues. Pray for relief and answers.
5. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - We have the opportunity to serve an artist in Ireland this month. Pray that God would bless our time at an art opening tonight, and that many non-believers would be touched through the exhibition.
6. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me as I'll be sharing from the Word in Eglwysbach.
7. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please continue to pray for Grm. Ask that God would open the door again to talk about Jesus and his saving work for us.
8. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for our health. I have been very sick for almost a month now. After many visits to the doctor they are still trying to get me back to 100%. Pray for healing and that this will pass quickly.
9. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 7)** - Please pray for me as I am raising funds and preparing to be back to Wales on April 12.

10. Thu - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Pray for us as we host a large dinner in our home this month. Pray that God would use times like this to further His kingdom, and that we would be able to clearly share the Gospel.
11. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Today is my last day of work in the local hospital in Bangor. Please ask that God would continue to use different words and actions of mine to witness to Jesus Christ.
12. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please continue to pray for a not-yet-believing friend who has cancer. She continues to undergo treatment and is still VERY sick. Pray for healing and that she would personally come to know the Great Healer.
13. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Every week we have lots of kids playing in our house. Pray we can reach them with the Gospel though we don't feel we have freedom to directly evangelize them.
14. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me to have new opportunities to connect with people in ways that lead to Gospel conversations.
15. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Today is my last day in Wales. I will be transitioning to a new opportunity in Norway. I am so very thankful for the last 13 years here. Please pray that God would continue to grow seeds planted here, strengthen others in the Faith and also open new doors for ministry in Norway for me.
16. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Please pray for the few youth guys that I have invested in while being back in Texas. For their growth and pursuit in discipleship.
17. Thu - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - We give thanks for two prayer walking projects last month. The two projects were both very successful and were great encouragements to us on the field.
